

A home east of Jenkins was burglarized October 1, 2009. The owner stated that items were stolen from a trailer house that is located on his property. The trailer house was being used for storage while they complete their home. On October 1, the owner had been in the trailer house at approximately 5:00 pm and stated that everything was ok. When he returned to the mobile home someone had ransacked the contents and several items were missing.

These items include:

- 1 set of necklace, ring and earrings with pearls and diamonds
- 1 heart shaped diamond and ruby necklace
- 1 Sony VHS camcorder with case and charger
- 1 Marlin BB gun
- 1 double barrel shotgun 12 gauge
- 1 tackle box with assorted antique fishing lures
- 1 1910 Wade Highback Saddle & Tack
- 1 Sanyo 32" flat screen television

The suspect(s) also attempted to move a large gun safe but was unable to do so. Fingerprints were taken and have been sent to the Missouri State Crime Laboratory for analysis and possible identification.
